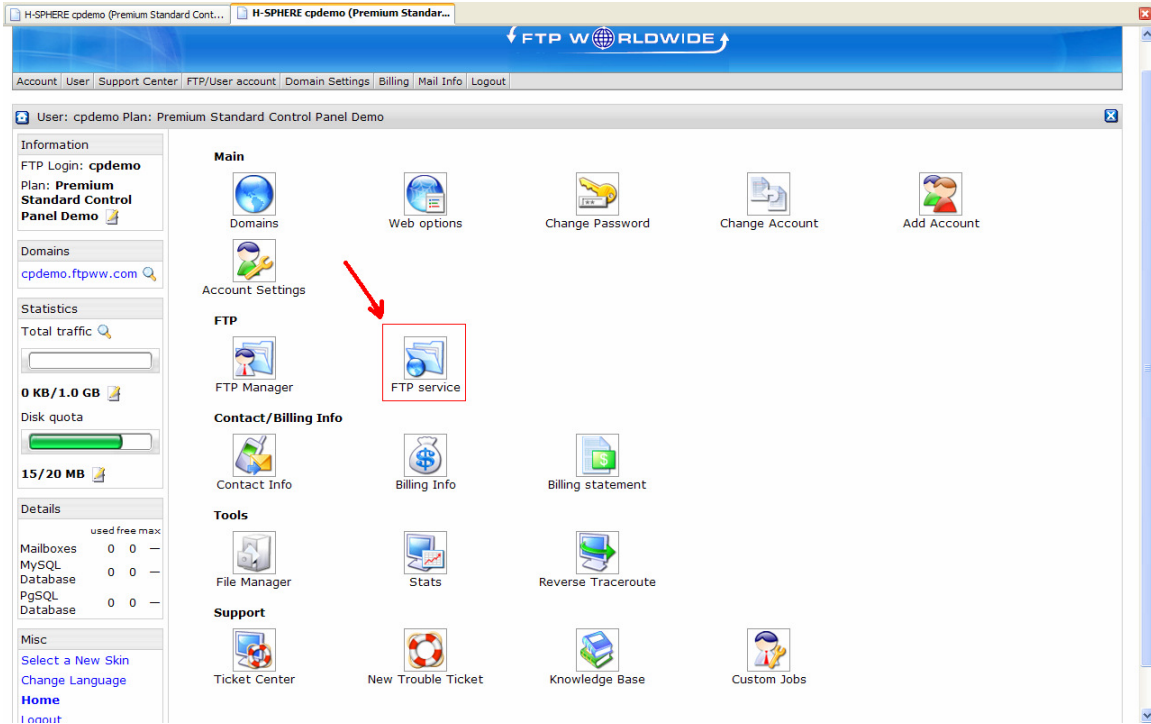

Virtual FTP-User ID / Password Setup

STEP 1: Log in to your Control Panel and click on FTP Service



STEP 2: Click on  next to *Virtual ftp-user* to create ID and set password.














STEP 6: Click on  next to **Virtual ftp-directories** to create directory and set permissions. Then click on SUBMIT.

Notes:

- If you have created Sub-Account IDs under FTP MANAGER and want to hide them from Virtual Users when they log in to the FTP Site, you need to add the Sub-Account directory as a Virtual FTP directory. Then uncheck “Grant permissions for all users” and don’t assign any Authorized users to see this directory.
- If creating a nested Virtual Directory structure (i.e. **test1/subfolder/**), be sure to create the primary directory first (i.e. **test1/**). Otherwise, the ownership will be given to ROOT and you will not have permission to make changes.
- There are 3 protected system folders that can not be hidden. They are – a virtual server folder (i.e. 12345), logs, and stats.
